

## Explore the Unique Aspects of Life in Jupiter and the Inner Workings of Jupiter's Local Government!

Using the Town's strategic plan as a framework, this program is designed around the six "themes" in Jupiter's strategic plan:

These themes define the long-term goals for the community and determine the programs and initiatives offered and developed by the local government.

During the sessions, you will learn about Jupiter's history and heritage, and how it has shaped life in Jupiter today. You will understand how the Town's natural, physical, recreational, and financial assets are managed by Town leaders to enhance quality of life, provide a safe and secure community, and provide for managed growth and a strong local economy. You will have an opportunity to meet each member of Jupiter's town council, the town manager, and key members of town staff who will help you to understand town programs, and have an opportunity to ask questions of your local leaders.

This is a panel/moderator style course, held at FAU's Jupiter campus in the Lifelong Learning Center. It is designed to be informative and interactive, and participants will be offered optional tours of town areas or facilities as a supplement to the panel sessions.
