

## 2010 Neighborhood Residential Grants

### **Community Building Grants**

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Community Building Grants were offered to neighborhood groups and HOAs to improve their social capital. Grants would be made for projects or materials that improve communication among neighbors.

### **HOA Distress Grants**

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Support is available to homeowner associations that are experiencing hardship in maintaining the external appearance of their properties due to foreclosures and non-payment of fees. Funds were available for external maintenance or improvement projects that are a direct result of the non-payment of dues. Funds were available to supplement an ongoing deficit.

#### **Georgian Park**

This request is to pressure clean sidewalks; clean and renumber parking stops and landscape the entrance.

#### **Clocktower Hammock**

This request is to replace grass, trees and plants in the common areas and front entrance of the neighborhood.

#### **Riverwalk HOA**

This request is to repair the community pool with cracks in the finish and deck causing the pool to leak; the finish is worn allowing the growth of black algae.

### **Neighborhood Improvement Grants - \$500 - \$5,000**

Funding is available to each community once every five years beginning with awardees from 2008. Communities are able to build or enhance an attribute of their community that benefits the town, and can be viewed by a public road. Community participation is a key element to this proposal as is the need for the improvement. Proposals may include entrance way improvements and signs, landscaping, safety enhancements, and lights.

#### **Chasewood North**

Application is to landscape front entrance on the Central Blvd. entrance, the Westerly Center Island. The improved landscaping will enhance the appearance of Central Blvd.

#### **Indian Creek Phase V Stillwater Circle**

The application is for adding four street lights in the dark areas of the Circle; the homes face the lake and Indian Creek Park and will correlate to public safety for residents and will assist Jupiter Police while on random patrol. The application is to also to replace existing street light bonnets and to install an entrance sign to identify the Indian Creek Phase.

#### **Indian Creek Phase VIII Eagle Ridge**

This application is to replace rotted railroad ties with a cement wall on one of the entrances to the community; replace landscaping and palm trees destroyed by the hurricanes and repair the sprinkler system in the common areas.

**Sea Colony Community Association**

This application is to renovate the front entrance and add new landscaping.

**Villas at Ocean Dunes**

This application is to provide lighting and landscaping upgrades to the public entrance of the community.
