## 2011 School's Out Camp Reminders:

### Daily Camp Checklist:

- Dress your campers in camp shirt & sneakers every day; be sure they are dressed appropriately for the day's activities
- Send your camper with a soft-sided cooler with lunch, snacks & bottle of water
- Bring field trip fees and extra \$ for goodies every morning (cash only; exact change)
- Bring photo identification for afternoon pick up every day

### NOT PERMITTED

For safety and liability purposes, parents and campers are asked to strictly adhere to the following list of **items** not permitted at camp:

1. Cell Phones
2. Gameboys, PSP's or other handheld game systems
3. Portable DVD players
4. I-Pods, MP3 players or anything requiring headphones
5. Sandals, flip-flops, dress shoes, skate shoes, any type of Croc's
6. Toys and/or stuffed animals



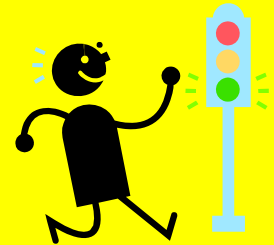
The items listed above often create a very large distraction and safety hazard for campers and counselors. Counselors cannot be responsible for holding items for campers. Anyone found to be in possession of a non-permitted item will have the item confiscated by the Lead Counselor and returned to the parent at afternoon sign out. Please note that items similar to those listed above have been lost, misplaced and/or stolen in previous camps.

### Disciplinary Procedures

The following **behaviors** will not be tolerated at camp and will be disciplined according to the discipline procedures:

1. Bullying
2. Disrespect to others
3. Fighting
4. Cursing
5. Stealing
6. Not following rules & directions
7. Not listening to counselors
8. Destruction of Town or other people's property



Parent cooperation is expected and appreciated for all cases of negative behavior requiring disciplinary action. If a child demonstrates undesirable or disturbing behavior or is continually disregarding staff, the following disciplinary procedures will be followed:

1. **Verbal Warning** - Children will receive a verbal warning from the counselors and/or group Coordinator.
2. **First Written Warning "Yellow Note"** - If the child still continues having trouble after several verbal warnings, a written notice, or "Yellow Note" will be sent home for the parent's signature. The child must return the notice signed by a parent the following day.
3. **Phone Call** - If the "Yellow Note" is not returned and/or the undesirable behavior is still evident, parents can expect a phone call from a youth camp coordinator. A Parent/Camp Coordinator conference may be scheduled at this time to discuss the child's future in the program and possible ways to alter the undesirable behavior.
4. **Second Written Warning "Red Note" &/or Suspension** - If the child still continues having trouble, a second written notice, or "Red Note" will be sent home for the parent's signature and a Parent/Camp Coordinator meeting will be scheduled to discuss the child's suspension from camp. Certain behaviors will automatically result in a "Red Note" as determined by the Lead Counselor and Camp Coordinator of the child's group. A child will be sent home if the child's negative behavior warrants immediate removal from the camp. The suspension duration is at the discretion of the camp director and will be based on the behavior and attitude of the child.
5. **Dismissal** - If steps 1-4 have not been successfully met the child will be expelled from the program with a prorated refund.
