NEWS RELEASE

January 31, 2008 -- Subsequent to a narcotics investigation, the Jupiter Police Department executed a search warrant at the residence of 180 Pinewood Court, Jupiter, Florida. On January 31, 2008, at approximately 6:00 am, members of the Critical Response Team executed the warrant at the aforementioned location. Upon entry, contact was made with, Zachary Howard, w/m 10/10/83 and Cory Howard, w/m 06/27/86. A search of the residence revealed, approximately 42 grams of cocaine, small amounts of marijuana, Xanax, two stolen firearms and nearly \$17,000 in cash.

In 2005, Zachary Howard was convicted and sentenced to nearly 7 years in state prison for drug trafficking charges pertaining to a prior Jupiter Police Department investigation. He is currently on supervised probation. As a result of this search warrant, Zachary Howard was charged with Grand Theft of a Firearm, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and Violation of Probation.

Cory Howard was subsequently charged with Armed Trafficking in Cocaine, Possession of Xanax, Possession of Marijuana, and Grand Theft of a Firearm.

Both subjects were processed and later transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.
