Homicide Investigation

May 6, 2011 – At approximately 2:30AM, the North County Communications Center received several 9-1-1 calls regarding possible gun shots in the area of Allen Street, North Palm Beach Heights, Jupiter.

Officers responding to the incident located a white male, 31 years-of-age at the corner of Kendrick Street and Marrian Avenue who appeared to have sustained a gunshot wound. Further investigation revealed a second victim in a residence within the 6200 block of Allen Street. The victim, white male, 23 years-of-age had also sustained a gunshot wound and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Suspect information obtained during the preliminary investigation indicates a black male subject, mid 20's, approximately 6'00", short cropped hair, last seen wearing a light colored shirt and blue jeans left the area possible operating a gold colored Dodge Durango.

At this point of our investigation, this incident does not appear to be a random act of violence as there are indicators that this shooting may be narcotics related.
