BUSINESS OWNERS CHARGED IN SCHEME TO DEFRAUD

March 31, 2011 – Allstar Magazine owners, Gidget Moers (7/13/77) and Bambi Moers (6/5/80), were arrested this morning following a year long investigation. The company produces magazines and calendars to promote high school information, current events, school news, school clubs, and school conduct policies. Allstar Magazine, based out of Royal Palm Beach, Florida, solicits local businesses to buy ad space in their magazine. The company posed as representatives from local high schools and in some cases was allegedly entered in a contract with high school administrators. They were to produce a specific number of magazines and/or calendars for the school who then, in turn, sells them for their booster sales.

As a result of the investigation, it was determined that the suspects were collecting the money from the businesses, but failed to produce the magazines for the schools. Moreover, the investigation revealed hundreds of contracts signed with businesses throughout Palm Beach County with approximately 10 Palm Beach County Schools affected.
