ATTEMPTED ROBBERY/AGGRAVATED BATTERY

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: December 23, 2011 (9:15PM)

Jupiter, Florida – On December 23, 2011 at 0235 hours, the North County Regional Communications Center received a 911 call regarding a male beating up a female in front of the Wal-Mart store, located at 2144 W. Indiantown Rd. When officers arrived on scene, they discovered the victim inside the store lying on the ground and bleeding severely from her head.

Investigation determined two suspects, wearing ski masks, tried to grab the victim's purse as she was walking to her car. The victim grabbed onto her purse to avoid the suspects attempts. The victim's boyfriend, who was waiting in the vehicle, attempted to stop the attack as the suspects were striking the victim in the head with a blunt object. During the struggle, the victim's boy friend was able to remove the ski mask from one of the suspects and immediately recognized them as someone he had talked to when he was inside the store. When the victim would not give up her purse, the suspects ran back to their vehicle and fled the scene. The victim's boyfriend was also able to obtain a license plate number from the vehicle prior to the vehicle exiting the parking lot.

With the information provided, Detectives conducted their investigation, which resulted in identifying the two suspects as Jaclyn Galczynski (W/F 10/27/87) and Tracy Bradley (B/M 05/23/91). They have been arrested and charged with Attempted Robbery and Aggravated Battery.

No additional information is available concerning this incident, at this time.
