Intensive Enforcement Initiative on Impaired Driving

Jupiter, Florida – The Jupiter Police Department will join nearly 10,000 other law enforcement agencies nationwide in support of an intensive enforcement initiative on impaired driving August 19th through September 5th, known as “*Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over.*”

We will be aggressively looking for all impaired drivers during this enforcement initiative and will arrest anyone we find driving while impaired — regardless of age, vehicle type or time of day. “Our message is simple and unwavering: if we find you driving impaired, we will arrest you,” said Chief Frank Kitzerow.

“All too often, innocent, law-abiding people suffer tragic consequences and the loss of loved ones due to this careless disregard for human life. Because we’re committed to keep our community safe by detecting and deterring impaired drivers, we’re intensifying enforcement during the initiative. Since twice as many alcohol-impaired accidents occur over the weekend and four times as many occur at night, we will be especially vigilant during these high-risk times when impaired drivers are most likely to be on our roads,” said Chief Frank Kitzerow.

“In 2010, 110 DUI arrests were made by the Jupiter Police Department. Driving impaired is simply not worth all the consequences. So don’t take the chance. Remember, “drive sober or get pulled over,” said Chief Frank Kitzerow.
