MANHUNT RESULTS IN HOMICIDE SUSPECT ARRESTED

May 11, 2011 – Approximately eleven months ago, on June 29, 2010 a double shooting occurred at 6257 Allen Street. The male and female residents inside were both shot. John Anderson (W/M 07-06-78) died as a result of the shooting. A \$36,000 reward was established through the Federal Bureau of Investigations and Palm Beach County Crime Stoppers for the apprehension of the suspect responsible for this incident.

Through intense investigative efforts and a tip received through Crime Stoppers a suspect was identified. The Jupiter Police Department, in cooperation with the Federal Bureau of Investigations, the Orangeburg (South Carolina) County Sheriff's Office and the Orangeburg Department of Public Safety, the suspect, Fares Mustafa (01/08/1981), was apprehended without incident at a location in Orangeburg, South Carolina.

Fares Mustafa has been charged with first degree murder and attempted first degree murder in connection with the shooting on June 29, 2010. He will await extradition back to the State of Florida.

The Jupiter Police Department would like to thank the members of the Federal Bureau of Investigation Columbia and Miami Divisions, S.A.C. David A. Thomas, S.A.C. John Gillies, Sheriff Leroy Ravenell, O.C.S.O. and Chief Wendell Davis, O.C.P.S. and their staffs for their exemplary cooperation during this apprehension.

Although the Jupiter Police Department apprehended a suspect yesterday for the homicide that occurred last week on May 6, 2011 on the same street, there is no indication that these two incidents are related in any way.

Additional details concerning this investigation and any potential subsequent arrests will be provided as it becomes available.
