SHOOTING SUSPECT APPREHENDED IN TEXAS

December 8, 2010 – Following a two week long investigation, the Jupiter Police Department was able to identify the suspect responsible for the shooting incident that occurred on November 27, 2010. As mentioned in a previous press release, the Jupiter Police Department responded to a traffic crash at Indiantown Road and Military Trail involving two vehicles. A silver blue Volkswagen struck the traffic light control box at the northeast corner of the intersection and then struck a black sedan. The driver and sole occupant of the Volkswagen was discovered to have injuries inconsistent with the traffic crash. He told officers that he had been shot, in an apparent traffic altercation, in the area of Hepburn Avenue and Evernia Street.

The investigation led to the identity of the shooting suspect as, Victor Garcia Lozano (09/30/76). With the assistance from the United States Marshals Service, Lozano was located in Kaufman, Texas where he was arrested without incident earlier this date. Lozano has been charged with attempted murder and will be awaiting extradition back to the State of Florida.
