VEHICLE BURGLARY SUSPECT ARRESTED

On July 21, 2009 at approximately 7:51 pm, officers from the Jupiter Police Department responded to a report of a suspicious white male subject in the parking lot near Gold's Gym, 201 N. US Highway One. The caller advised that the subject was pulling on several car door handles. Upon arrival, officers observed a subject, matching the description provided by the caller, inside a red BMW vehicle. The owner of the unlocked vehicle was located and advised that he did not know the subject nor did he give permission to the subject to enter his vehicle. The subject was later identified as Taylor J. Sessa (DOB 10/26/1987).

Sessa was found to have property from the vehicle inside his pockets. He was also in possession of property that was not his and did not belong to the owner of the BMW. Sessa was charged with burglary and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail.

At approximately 10:06 pm, a caller reported that credit cards and cash had been removed from her unlocked vehicle while it was parked in the lot near the Jupiter 18 Theatre, 204 N. US Highway One. This victim's credit cards were recovered from Sessa at the time of his arrest. Sessa was charged with an additional burglary charge in addition to a theft charge.

Sessa is a Jupiter resident and since 2005 he has been arrested by the Jupiter Police Department six times and by the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office four times. Those charges include burglary, shoplifting, carrying a concealed weapon, aggravated assault with a weapon, narcotics related charges and probation violation.
