June 26, 2009 – On Friday, June 26, 2009 at approximately 12:21 am, members of the Jupiter Police Department responded to a traffic crash with injuries that occurred on Alternate A1A, just north of the Three Palms Plaza. At the time of the crash, the northbound right lane was shut down and construction crews were on scene completing a road-resurfacing project.

Upon conducting the investigation, it was discovered that a Toyota Solara, traveling north on Alternate A1A, struck three of the workers from the construction crew and another vehicle, a Toyota Camry which was also traveling north. Two of the workers were pronounced deceased on scene and one was transported to Jupiter Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries.

The female driver of the Toyota Solara and the male driver of the Toyota Camry did not sustain any injuries in the crash.

This case is currently under investigation by Officer Philip Gelina. Any further inquiries should be directed through Officer Sally Collins-Ortiz, Public Information Officer.
