TRAFFIC CRASH

December 3, 2008 – On Tuesday, December 2, 2008 at approximately 11:21 p.m., members of the Jupiter Police Department responded to the area of Indiantown Road and Alternate A1A regarding a crash with injuries.

Upon conducting the investigation, it was discovered that Donald Charles Peer III (w/m 10/20/1975) was driving his black 2008 Jeep SUV northbound on Alternate A1A. Peer's vehicle struck the passenger side of a silver 2004 Hyundai four-door driven by Werner Bruderek II (w/m 04/11/1986). Bruderek was traveling eastbound on Indiantown Road. Following the impact, Bruderek's vehicle was pushed more than 100-feet to the northeast corner of the intersection.

Peer, a Jupiter resident, was transported to the Jupiter Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries. Bruderek, a Palm Beach Gardens resident, was transported via air to St. Mary's Hospital with critical injuries.
