IV. REPORTS:

1. Financial Report - Satu Oksanen reviewed the copy of the budget that had been distributed. She noted the expenditures for printing \$437 and \$443.
2. A I P P Update - Carol Shain announced that the A I P P committee was to be on the agenda for the Jupiter Town Council March 19, 2019. The election for Jupiter Town Council is March 12 and the committee will be meeting with the newly elected officials to bring them up to date on the mural project. It is important that each council member be informed before the A I P P committee is on the agenda to appear before the council. The estimated cost for the bucket boat is \$14500 per week. They are also waiting for the permitting for the proposal.
3. Budget Sub Committee - Lois Taylor asked members to provide her with copies of expenditures so she can keep a current record of budget expenditures.
4. Marketing and advertising - Brenda Nickolaus has contacted newspapers and they are very interested with what the committee is doing. They are on Face Book, but do not do the e-mail blasts. It was questioned if the Marketing Sub Committee would be involved with the mural under the bridge. The response was

affirmative. There was discussion regarding the Town of Jupiter's publication Town Times and the Department of Community Relations. It was concluded that they would be involved in a marketing campaign for the progress of the mural under the bridge. The sub committee has also instituted a program to reach out to community schools to establish a relationship and improve communication. Judy Wolfe and Lou Ann Berkley will be setting up meetings with the teachers.

5. Art Exhibit March 1, 2019- Faye Schrecengost noted that 19 applications have been received, entries 45 before the deadline of February 22, 2019.
6. North Palm Beach Cultural Alliance - Dorothy Katz Researched the Google ad a gram for non-profits, The Art Committee does not qualify. It does not have a 501-C 3 status and is an entity of a municipality.
7. Jubilee, February 2, 2019 - Members who manned the art table at the event commented that it had more attendance than when it was held at the Jupiter Town Hall site. It was fun and people seemed to be having a good time. The art table needs more materials for handout to cover all the art events.
