the year). Right now, they haven't asked us to be on committees. Members have certain committees they would like to volunteer on for Centennial so they may be reaching out on their own. Satu wants us to let her know who ends up on what committee if we are able to secure a spot. They are looking at businesses, non-profits, et al. Elizabeth will keep us updated on Shawn Reed's unveiling.

It was a successful set up and many people came by with their kids to get swag and coloring pages to take home. Our table looked great!

V **OLD BUSINESS:** a. New Town Hall Art Celebration show went well with minimal expense and work already having been done ahead of time with the "opening/ribbon cutting event. It was nice to have the focus on the "artists" in this event that resulted. The town hall chambers was also complete with Art Photos hanging. The event was a success. Not sure if there will be a follow up brochure...we will be finding out through Satu.

VI: **NEW BUSINESS:** a. * We welcomed the NEW MEMBERS earlier in meeting as noted. 3 NEW members still need to be recognized/introduced in a future meeting: Erin Colin, Maria Merigliano Rodriguez, and Arielle Yebba.

b. **The Fall Show:** Discussions around what we will do as our FIRST Gallery Show back after the summer. It was discussed that we need to **set up a calendar of shows**...however, nothing was set in stone yet (or voted on). Lots of ideas were discussed, but we started with looking at our calendars for the FIRST date (which we had discussed loosely in previous meetings) as **OCTOBER 4th!** *Drop off would be September 23rd and 24th*, and the show would **RUN Oct. 4th - December 8th** with *pick up on Dec. 9th*. Theme not decided on...talk of another Art and Authors idea and using the Play Room again...finding out availability?

- Other dates to follow were: January 24th (100 year history year theme related? Exhibit would run through March 3rd closing date.
- Spring 4th show? April Earth Day theme? Keep in mind Easter is April 20th. Need to worry about Camps interfering with scheduled dates.
- Committee to go and think of possible themes as well as dates they are available for volunteering on the Gallery Show. Dylan will be doing her first shot of overseeing computer work for Gallery artist shows...taking over from Elizabeth, so there needs to be some learning room in there for her.

VII: HARBORSIDE: Per Robin, artists already in chosen, waiting on artist for fourth case. Brenda filled 4th case and all art is in place for all 4 cases! Art will be in until between the end of May and early June.
