

**Town of Jupiter

1. Approval of Agenda

3. Approval of Minutes October 18, 2021

Vice Chair Sara Misselhorn moved to approve the minutes as corrected; seconded by Board Member Lee Webber. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Staff Updates –

a. Seminole War Convocation

Ms. Stephanie Thoburn presented the Seminole War Historians Convocation update. Ms. Thoburn stated that staff and the HRB Chair Debi Murray attended the 2022 event held on April 1-3 which provided thought provoking presentations and displays that provided an in-depth perspective of the Seminole War. The Town presented a Proclamation signed by the Mayor recognizing the importance of the 2022 Convocation of Seminole War Historians Proclamation. Ms. Thoburn stated that it was good to hear of a different perspective of the Seminole history.

Seminole War Convocation – cont'd

Chair Debi Murray added how profoundly different the stories are from the Florida Seminole perspective compared to Oklahoma Seminole prospective.

Chair Debi Murray and Ms. Thoburn shared an overview of the Seminole Event. The experience could be expressed by many young Seminole stating, "I'm home, come home to our home land!" This was a first time Seminoles from Oklahoma visited Florida since they were forced to emigrate.

b. Historic Preservation Proclamation

Ms. Thoburn informed the Board of the Historic Preservation Proclamation. The Mayor will be proclaiming the Month of May Historic Preservation Month at the April 19, 2022 Town Council meeting. Ms. Thoburn asked the HRB members if they would be able to attend to accept the proclamation. Vice Chair Sara Misselhorn, Dave Thompson, Lee Weber and Brad Mayo advised they would attend.

c. Brooker House (Certificate of Appropriateness and Historic Grant update)

Ms. Thoburn confirmed the renovations of the Brooker House were successfully completed. The house was redone according to the Certificate of Appropriateness. The modifications were the same as the original, as intended.

Chair Debi Murray, asked if they have a plaque for the Brooker House.

Ms. Thoburn confirmed the plaque is done and will need to be given to them.

d. Jupiter FEC Train Depot – Interior build out

Ms. Thoburn, advised that there is funding to work on the interior of the Train Depot. However, we would like to save as much money as we can. We are currently doing it in stages due to expenses with contracting. Public Works staff has also agreed to assist us with some of the construction work to reduce costs. Staff would like to get donations where we can and reduced rates from contractors in Town. Ms. Thoburn also reminded the Board this is a slow-going process, but is going.

e. San Miguel Archangel Anchor and Cannons recoating

Ms. Thoburn stated that the anchor and cannons recently received a recoating to protect the artifacts from degrading. Approximately 5 or 8 years ago they were sent to the state, where they were soaked in acid for several months to ensure all cracks are sealed. The recoating helps with the salt given proximity to the ocean.

f. Updated Jupiter History Map on the Town’s Webpage

Ms. Thoburn discussed the Jupiter Town History Map. Ms. Thoburn advised the Board of future plans by Community Relations Department to develop an interactive map.

5. BOARD COMMENTS:

Board Member, Brad Mayo asked if there were any updates regarding the possible designation for the Old Town Hall.

Ms. Thoburn informed the Board that there are future plans to work on that project as part of the upcoming Comprehensive Plan.

Chairperson, Debi Murray congratulated the new Council Members and the new Town Mayor.
