Replace pre-existing sign destroyed by hurricane with temporary sign

1. The maximum amount of time in which the temporary signs may be permitted shall be three months from the storm event, which is January 24, 2006. All temporary signs that are not covered by Section 27-1883, entitled "Temporary signs" shall be removed by the noted time frame, unless it can be documented that a replacement sign has been delayed and is currently being permitted and constructed.
2. Temporary signs are to replace approved, pre-existing freestanding and/or façade signs (i.e. if a tenant in a shopping center loses the freestanding sign but not the façade sign only the freestanding sign may be replaced). If no signage existed for a business or tenant prior to the storm, a temporary sign shall not be permitted for that business.
3. Signs must be located in the general location as the original pre-existing freestanding and/or façade signs. Signs shall not be located within required sight distance triangles, and must be setback a minimum of 10' from the right-of-way. Signs must not be attached to landscaping, utility poles, etc. as specified in Section 27-1733, entitled "Prohibited signs".
4. Temporary signs shall not exceed the approved sign copy square footage as originally permitted.
5. Temporary signs may be constructed of a variety of materials including cloth, wood, plastic, cardboard, etc.

In consideration of the granting of the requested temporary permit, I do hereby agree that I will in all respects perform the work in accordance with the interim policy as noted above, relative to temporary signs within the Town of Jupiter. I understand that the temporary sign must be removed by January 24, 2006 and will comply.
