TOWN OF JUPITER **ELECTION – MARCH 12, 2019**

The Town of Jupiter General Election will be held on **Tuesday, March 12, 2019** between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the following **three** seats:

Mayor Seat – Three Year Term – Candidate must live in Jupiter

First District Seat - Three Year Term - Candidate must live in the First District.

Second District Seat - Three Year Term - Candidate must live in the Second District.

Notice of Candidacy

Candidate qualifying will be held from 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday, January 2, 2019 through 12:00 P.M. Noon Tuesday, January 15, 2019 in the Town Clerk's Office at 210 Military Trail, Jupiter, FL .

Filing Fees:	Mayor	\$257
	First/Second District	\$221

The Filing Fee is \$35.00 plus 1.0% of annual salary, with a check drawn on the Campaign Depository. All Candidates must be registered voters and have resided in the Town for 6 months prior to the election.

All Candidates shall be elected by the Voters of the Town at Large on a nonpartisan basis. If a run-off Election is necessary, it will be held on Tuesday, March 26, 2019.

Voter Registration

The Registration Books for the Tuesday, March 12, 2019 Municipal Election will close on February 11, 2019.

Vote-by-Mail

The deadline to request that a vote-by-mail ballot be mailed is no later than 5 p.m. on March 6, 2019. Otherwise, a vote-by-mail ballot can be picked-up at the Supervisor of Elections office until and including on Election Day or visit www.pbcelections.org.
