This spring, the Town of Jupiter Recreation Department continues to have a full schedule of events for all Jupiter residents. We hope you were able to come out to the return of our largest event, Jupiter Jubilee, in January. It was nice to see Town residents of all ages enjoying the food, music, demonstrations and fun activities.

With Easter just around the corner, the Town is hosting a few fun events for kids from tots to pre-teens. From April 4 to April 10, the Town is hosting its Easter Egg Scavenger Hunt. During this time, participants can visit either Jupiter Community Park or Abacoa Community Park to find nine “eggs” with letters on the back that will decode a message from the Easter Bunny himself. For young bunnies ages 5 and under, the Town is hosting a Hippity Hop Hunt, that will include games, crafts and a special visit from the Easter Bunny, on Thursday, April 14. Lastly, for 7 to 14 year olds, the Town is bringing back the Glow in the Dark Egg Hunt. ## Easter Egg Scavenger Hunt

The Easter Bunny is hoppin' into Town on a special mission this spring. He is hiding nine eggs at two Town of Jupiter Parks, Abacoa Community Park and Jupiter Community Park, for residents to find in a self-guided scavenger hunt. After finding all of the eggs, a secret message from the Easter Bunny himself will be revealed. Families can complete the hunt at either park, but do not need to go to both.

The first 1,500 participants to find all nine hidden eggs and discover the Easter Bunny's secret message will receive an Easter giveaway bag. The eggs will be hidden from Monday, April 4 to Sunday, April 10.

#### HERE IS HOW IT WILL WORK:

- Download your scavenger hunt sheet at [www.jupiter.fl.us/EasterEggHunt](http://www.jupiter.fl.us/EasterEggHunt) starting on April 1. You can also stop by the Jupiter Community Center's front desk to pick up a copy. One sheet will have clues for Abacoa Community Park and another will have the clues for Jupiter Community Park. The hunts will be the same, so residents only need to pick one park. These sheets will give hints to the nine egg locations in each park.
- Go to the park you choose, Abacoa Community Park or Jupiter Community Park, to find the hidden eggs. Now, these aren't your typical eggs. The Easter Bunny dropped off his egg-specially large eggs, so that they can be easily spotted. On the back of each egg you will find a letter. Write the letter you find at each location in its corresponding space on your scavenger hunt sheet.
- After you find all the eggs and have all your letters, you will see the Easter Bunny's secret message. Bring this completed sheet back to the Community Center's front desk by Tuesday, April 12 to claim your prize.
