## CLUES:

1. \_\_\_\_\_: The Easter Bunny left the first egg out in plain view for all to see. If you enter Abacoa Community Park from Frederick Small Road you will notice the first egg right next to the park sign.

2. \_\_\_\_\_: The Easter Bunny thought the park rules were important to know, so he hid the second egg by the sign that covers the rules.

3. \_\_\_\_\_: While watching the amazing tricks from the skaters, the Easter Bunny left the third egg at the entrance to this main park attraction.

4. \_\_\_\_\_: Hiding eggs takes the energy out of you, so next the Easter Bunny took a break under the pavilion and watched some roller hockey. He left the next egg in this restful place.

5. \_\_\_\_\_: After his rest, the Easter Bunny checked out the playground, went for a swing and hid egg number five!

6. \_\_\_\_\_: Swinging gave the Easter Bunny an appetite, so he hopped over to the concession stand to hunt for a snack. While there, he hid the sixth egg.
